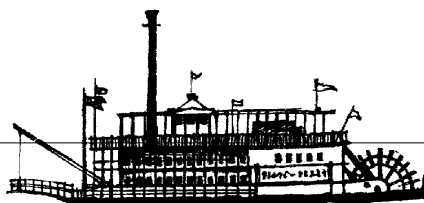
- 4 Here is a map showing the Mississippi River. Where does Huck go? Write chapter numbers on the map. The length of his journey in days and nights will help you.
