Jamie Keddie is a teacher trainer, writer and storyteller. He studied Biochemistry at the University of Aberdeen but found his true passion in life as an English teacher in Barcelona. Jamie has shared his ideas with teachers and educators in over 40 countries. He is the founder of Lessonstream.org, a resource site dedicated to the use of video and other visual materials in the classroom. In 2008, he won a British Council ELTons award for his work.

Through Power-Up: Video and Image:

- You will gain a deeper understanding of the potential for images and video in the language classroom.
- You will take away a wealth of knowledge about how to create activities and lesson plans around visual materials.
- You will develop a critical awareness of the visual media and know how to draw your own students' attention to this.
- You will learn about good practice for communicating in front of a video camera. You will learn how to pass on this information to your students.
