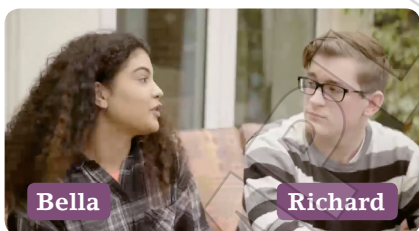
### Video skills
